Alcoholic Beverage Control Rules for Village Hall Facility Rentals

All persons applying to rent space in Marvin Village Hall in which alcohol (**beer and wine only** unless an ABC permit is obtained) will be served or brought by guests (**not sold**), must initial, sign, and date the following rules regarding use of these premises.

1.	All alcoholic beverages must remain in the "consumption area," which consists of the available rental areas (Council Chambers, Conference Room, and Grounds). No open alcoholic beverages are permitted in the parking lot, along the roadway, or within areas of the Village Hall that are not included in the rental agreement.
2.	All empty alcoholic beverage containers must be properly discarded at the conclusion of the event.
3.	Absolutely NO SALES of alcoholic beverages are permitted under any circumstances.
4.	All North Carolina laws regarding under-age serving and over-serving must be observed.
5.	Any person serving alcohol must be at least 21 years of age. Servers are not permitted to consume alcohol while working or have consumed prior to working.
6.	Alcohol may not be served before 10:00 am on Sundays.
7.	The event is subject to inspection by the Union County Sheriff's Office as well as the North Carolina Alcohol Law Enforcement Agents. Full cooperation must be given at all times.
8.	If alcohol is served, the server agrees to obtain insurance and name the Village of Marvin as an additional insured on the policy.
9.	The Release and Indemnity Agreement must be read and executed one week (7 days) prior to the event.
