## PROCLAIMING OCTOBER 25<sup>TH</sup> AS ARBOR DAY 2025 IN THE VILLAGE OF MARVIN

WHEREAS in 1872, J. Sterling Morton proposed to the Nebraska Board of Agriculture that a special day be set aside for the planting of trees; and

WHEREAS this holiday, called Arbor Day, was first observed with the planting of more than a million trees in Nebraska; and

WHEREAS Arbor Day is now observed throughout the nation and the world; and

WHEREAS trees can reduce erosion of our precious topsoil by wind and water, cutting heating and cooling costs, moderating the temperature, cleaning the air, producing life-giving oxygen, and providing habitat for wildlife; and

WHEREAS trees in our Village increase property values, enhance the economic vitality of commercial areas, and beautify our community; and

WHEREAS trees, wherever they are planted, are a source of joy and spiritual renewal; and

**WHEREAS** the Village aspires to be recognized as a Tree City USA by The National Arbor Day Foundation and commits the Village to take steps to enhance Marvin's tree canopy.

**NOW, THEREFORE,** I, Joseph E. Pollino Jr., Mayor of the Village of Marvin, do hereby proclaim that October 25<sup>th</sup>, 2025, as **ARBOR DAY** in the Village of Marvin, and I urge all citizens to celebrate Arbor Day and to support efforts to protect our trees and woodlands for the well-being of this and future generations.
