### Village of Marvin & Active Waste Solutions Bulk Drop-Off Day

**Date:** Saturday, April 11 & Saturday, October 17, 2026

**Time:** 9am-12pm Noon

**Location:** Marvin Village Hall (10006 Marvin School Road)



Active Waste Solutions and the Village of Marvin will be holding our BULK Day for Marvin residents on Saturday, April 11 and Saturday, October 17, 2026, from 9am -12pm at Marvin Village Hall. Residents may bring the acceptable bulky and electronic items listed below to Marvin Village Hall (10006 Marvin School Road) where Active Waste Solutions will provide roll off containers for the items' disposal or recycling.

In the event of extremely inclement weather on the day of the event, there will be a post on the Village's website about postponing the event. Please check the Village website ([www.MarvinNC.gov](http://www.MarvinNC.gov)) BEFORE heading to the event.

#### Acceptable Bulk Waste Items:

- Air conditioners - Window units only, not to exceed 45lbs.
- Basketball goal (portable) - Remove concrete base & dismantle; concrete will not be collected
- Bed and bed frames – Dismantle
- Bicycles
- Carpet/floor coverings- Roll & cut no longer than 4ft.; Up to 4 rolls accepted (max. 25lbs each)
- Couches/Chairs
- China cabinet hutches - Empty; tape any glass
- Desks/Dressers - Empty
- Entertainment centers - Empty; tape any glass
- Fencing - wood fences only, no metal fences. Remove or flatten protruding nails; 45lbs or less
- Fireplace inserts - Remove bricks; no bricks collected
- Garbage cans - Tag with a note indicating to take the can
- Glass doors, windows, table inserts - Using tape, make an X over the glass
- Grills - Remove propane tanks; 45lbs or less; no commercial grills.
- Gutters - 4ft or less.
- Lawnmowers - Remove gasoline, battery, oil, if applicable.
- Linoleum - Roll & cut no longer than 4ft; Up to 4 rolls accepted (max. 10lbs each)
- Mattresses – can be rejected upon sight of any contamination or not accepted at all due to landfill regulations
- Refrigerators
- Patio furniture
- Pianos or organs - 45lbs or less; dismantle.
- Play sets/swing sets- Remove concrete base and dismantle, remove or flatten nails
- Plumbing materials
- Plywood & paneling - No larger than 1 in. thick x 4 ft. x 4 ft.
- Pool Covers - Folded; only folded cover; 45lbs or less will be collected
- Space heaters, oil and kerosene heaters; Must be emptied
- Televisions - no consoles – weight limit 45lbs
- Toys (large)

#### Unacceptable Bulk Waste Items:

- Commercial equipment
- Tires
- Paint
- Batteries
- Yard Waste
- Construction and Demolition materials
- Used Motor Oil and Antifreeze
- Construction and Demolition material

#### PLEASE NOTE:

The unacceptable items listed above may be taken by the resident to the Union County Solid Waste Management Facility at 2125 Austin Chaney Road Monday - Friday 7 AM - 4PM and Saturday 8 AM - Noon. There is a small fee for some of these items which require special handling. For more information and questions on these items please visit the link below.

### ELECTRONICS RECYCLING

#### Acceptable Electronic Items:

- Cell phones
- Computers
- Tablets
- Printers
- Scanners
- Flat Screen Televisions and Monitors
- Cameras
- Audio and video equipment

#### Unacceptable Electronic Items:

- Old Cathode Ray Tube (CRT) TVs

**Note:** CRT TVs are accepted at the Union County Austin Chaney site for a fee of \$10 each. The County has a licensed contractor to process this item safely.

### DO's & DON'Ts for the Event

#### Do's

- Please read the announcements/posts on the Village website ([www.MarvinNC.gov](http://www.MarvinNC.gov)) regarding the event thoroughly before and on the day of the event, as the weather or other may affect the scheduling of the event.
- Please arrive during the event time frame - 8am to 12pm noon, not before or after.
- Please bring only your acceptable bulky items and electronics from lists provided.
- Please drive into parking lot and out of it at a safe low legal speed.
- Please be patient as we're accommodating others in attendance.
- Please keep a safe distance (at least 10ft) between your vehicle and the vehicle in front of you.
- Please only allow one able adult to exit your vehicle. This individual may assist Active Waste personnel in opening their truck bed or vehicle doors.
- Please stay in your car if your bulky item(s) are not being loaded.
- Please follow all directions with regards to driving and unloading your vehicle.
- Please use fair judgement about number of items. On site judgement will be made if it is determined any resident has brought excessive amounts of bulky waste or electronics from their household or multiple households.
  - Smaller items - you may bring several.
  - Bigger items - please limit to one per household.

#### Don'ts

- Please don't bring children to the event. (If you must, please keep children secured in your vehicle.)
- Please don't allow any passengers in your vehicle to get out of the vehicle.
- Please don't bring bulky items and electronics from multiple residences.
- Please don't bring soiled mattresses.
- Please don't tailgate the car in front of you.
- Please don't leave your vehicle unattended.
- Please don't attempt to load the bulky items or electronics into any container.
- Please don't park in such a way that you are endangering others or in a way that will impede the flow of traffic.
- Please don't drop off bulky items or electronics at the Village Hall before or after the event.

#### PLEASE NOTE:

Active Waste Solutions will provide bulk service to individual residents after the BULK Day event for a fee. We have offered this from the beginning of servicing the Village of Marvin. If residents cannot be at the BULK Day event, they can call customer service and request a list of acceptable items from customer service as well as pricing.
